A Casuall Question by an Indian (the day after Coll Lowe had been at my house with his L^{spps} Commission) with my further Examination of him upon it the 3^d of August 1681:

Indian. Why doe the Englishmen think that Robin Hood killed the people below at S^t Maries?

Because he was seene to goe over the Bay about that time with neere twenty Indians with him, and all other Indians living on that side have denied the murder.

Ind: I am sure Robin Hood did not doe it then, for I was one of the Indians went over with him.

How long is it since you went over the Bay with him?

Ind: Tis almost two moones.

How many Indians were you in Company?

Ind: We were 4 Choptank Indians, 5 Mattaponyes that live with us, two Pascattoway men and 4 Pascattoway weomen with Children

Did you meete with Ever a greate Canooe as you went downe Choptank River?

Ind: We saw a greate Canooe when we gott downe p. 232 almost as lowe as the Island where Coll Lowe lives a greate way from us.

Did the men in the Canooe call to you? Ind. Noe

Did you paddle away from them? Ind: Noe we went straite to Choptank Creeke.

Did you putt on shore there? Ind: Yes we went up to Peter Haddawayes.

Where did you goe from thence? Ind: over the Bay to John Watkins

What did you doe on t'other side the Bay?

Ind. Robin hood and two Indians more went to make a Canooe at W^m Richardsons but I with five Indians went a hunting to the head of Seavern and Maggaty River

How long did you stay out a hunting? Ind: five dayes.

Were you at any Englishmens houses?

Ind: Yes wee were at Murreens, Henry Ridgelys, Richard
