To which his Ex<sup>cy</sup> was pleased to Give his Assent by en-  
dorsing the Same viz<sup>t</sup>

May 9<sup>th</sup> 1700

On Behalfe of his Most Sacred Maj<sup>ty</sup> King William the  
third of England Scotland France and Ireland I will these to  
be Laws.

all Annex together w<sup>th</sup> the Broad Seale of this Province of  
Maryland

Which laws being soe Signed and Sealed his Ex<sup>cy</sup> was  
pleased to acquainte the house that he thought it convenient  
for his Maj<sup>ty</sup>s Service to Prorogue them untill the ninth day  
of July next And that they were thereby accordingly pro-  
rogued
