" May 25th 1705. On Behalf of her most sacred Majesty
Queen Ann &^{ca} I will this be a Law " Jo. Seymour

Which being done his Ex'cy was pleased to seal the same
severally with the broad Seal of this Province. Which Laws
being so signed & sealed his Ex'cy was pleased to acquaint
the House that he by the Advice of her Majesty's Council
thought it convenient for her Majesty's Service to prorogue
them until the 24th Day of July next and that they were
thereby accordingly prorogued.

And so ended this Session of Assembly this 25th Day of
May in the fourth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady
Queen Ann of England &^{ta} Anno Domini 1705
