Ordered the following Ordinance be prepared

Whereas the Inhabitants of Prince George's County have set forth to this present General Assembly That four of the Justices of that County Court have burthened that County with the unnecessary Charge and Expence of keeping a Ferry over Patuxent River at Mount Calvert and that without the Consent of the rest of the Justices and Inhabitants thereof to their great Damage, Oppression and Aggrievance It is therefore ordained by the Hon^{ble} President, Council and Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same That the Justices of Prince George's County Court do not presume upon any Pretence whatsoever to continue that Ferry at the County Charge any longer than their November Court this present year 1711 and that they yield all due Obedience to this Ordinance as they and every of them will answer the Contrary to the next General Assembly.
