The Petition of the Vcstry and Inhabitants of Prince Georges Parish in Frederic & Prince Georges Counties Humbly Sheweth— That the Parishioners residing upon and in the Neighborhood of a branch of Patuxent commonly called Hawlings River, are in the greatest want of a Chapel of Ease

This Petition therefore most humbly prayeth that his Excellency & the Honble the upper & Lower Houses of Assembly would be graciously pleased to pass an Act to empower the County Courts of Frederic and Prince George Counties to levy upon the Taxable
