*A PROPOSAL that the members of each board or commission which serves as the head of a principal department, except the governing board of an institution of higher education or the state public school system, shall be appointed by the governor; that their terms of office shall be prescribed by law in such manner that the governor, within six months of taking office following his election, shall be able to appoint up to one-third of them; and that such members may be removed as prescribed by law.*
