Resolution in favor of Randall H. Moale and others. Passed Feb. 24.

WHEREAS, it has been represented to this General Assembly, that a certain suit or suits, are now pending in Baltimore county court instituted against the collector employed to complete the the collection of Robert C. Asquith, late collector of the city of Baltimore, or of certain districts therein—Therefore,

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all proceedings against R. H. Moale and others, as securities of the said Robert C. Asquith, as collector, be and they are hereby suspended until the first day of January next; Provide, that nothing herein contained shall have any force or effect, unless the assent of R. H. Moale, George Winchester, and Charles Hogg, be filed in writing with the clerk of Baltimore county court, on or before the first day of May next.*
