Therefore, the General Assembly, reposing full confidence in the ability, integrity, wisdom and sound legal knowledge of the said Honorable James A. Stewart, and deeming it compatible with the public interests to extend his term of service—

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,
That the term of service of the Honorable James A. Stewart, Chief Judge of the First Judicial Circuit, and Associate Judge of the Court of Appeals, be and the same is hereby extended, and the said James A. Stewart continued in office as Chief Judge of the First Judicial Circuit until the Tuesday after the first Monday of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two, and until his successor is elected and qualified.
