

**Chapter 187.**

AN ACT to sanction the bequest under the last will and testament of Sarah T. Turpin, of Queen Anne's county, Maryland, to the Superannuated Fund Society of the Maryland Annual Conference of the Methodist Protestant Church.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland is hereby given to the bequest under the last will and testament of Sarah T. Turpin, late of Queen Anne's county, Maryland, deceased, of the sum of three hundred dollars, to the Superannuated Fund Society of the Maryland Annual Conference of the Methodist Protestant Church.

Sanction given.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

**Chapter 188.**

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and thirty of article three of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Baltimore County," and to re-enact the same with amendments, imposing additional duties upon certain constables in said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one hundred and thirty of article three of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Baltimore County," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted with amendments.

SEC. 130. *Be it enacted,* The constables of said county shall have from the first to the third day of the several terms of the Circuit Court for said county to appear before the grand jury, and they shall each be entitled to a per diem of two dollars

Per diem for attendance.
