Joint resolution extending the term of service of Hon. Edward Hammond as associate judge of the Fifth Judicial Circuit of Maryland until the expiration of the full period of fifteen years for which he was elected.

WHEREAS the Honorable Edward Hammond, of Howard county, now acting as associate judge of the Fifth Judicial Circuit of Maryland, was elected to that position on the first Tuesday next following the first Monday of November in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, for the term of fifteen years from the time of his election and until his successor should be elected and qualified, or until he should attain the age of seventy years; and, whereas, before the end of said term of fifteen years, and before the next regular session of the General Assembly he will have attained the age of seventy years, should he live so long; therefore, be it

Preamble.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That in view of his ability, integrity, wisdom, experience and sound legal knowledge, the said Honorable Edward Hammond be and he is hereby continued in the office of associate judge of the Fifth Judicial Circuit of Maryland for the remainder of the term for which he was so elected and until his successor shall be elected and qualified.
