

CHAPTER 3.

AN ACT to repeal sections one, ten, fourteen and thirty, of Article eleven, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Almshouse," as amended by the Act of eighteen hundred and eighty-four, chapter two hundred and forty-two, and to re-enact said sections with amendments, and to add further sections thereto, to be designated fourteen A, and thirty A.

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections one, ten, fourteen and thirty of Article eleven, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Almshouse," as amended by the act of eighteen hundred and eighty-four, chapter two hundred and forty-two, be, and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows :

Commissioners of Charities and Corrections.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That on the second Monday of February, eighteen hundred and eighty-six, and on that day every two years thereafter, the County Commissioners of Frederick county shall appoint five discreet and competent persons, residents of said county, two of whom shall be of an opposite political party from that of a majority of said County Commissioners to be Commissioners of Charities and Corrections, who shall hold office for the space of two years from the second Monday of February of their appointment, or until their successors are appointed and qualified; and should any person appointed by the County Commissioners to be Commissioners of Charities and Corrections fail, or neglect to qualify for thirty days, the County Commissioners shall fill the vacancy; and the term of the present Commissioners of Charities and Corrections shall end and expire on said second Monday of February, eighteen hundred and eighty-six.

May fill the vacancy.
