An Act to change the name of James Tolly Howard, of Harford County, Passed Jan 1, 1827

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,
That the name of James Tolly Howard, of Harford county, be altered and changed, and the same is hereby altered and changed to James Walter Tolly.

CHAP. II.

An Act to alter the time for the transaction of Equity business in the Coun- Passed Jan 5, 1827
ty Courts of the first Judicial District.

1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Act repealed
That the act, entitled, "An act setting apart the three first days
of the county courts of the first judicial district for the trans-
action of equity business," be and the same is hereby repealed.

2. *And be it enacted,* That from and after the passage of
this act, it shall be the duty of the judges of the first judicial
district, to set apart the three last days in each and every term
thereafter, if so much time should be necessary, for the hearing
and deciding of causes pending on the equity side of the coun-
ty courts in that district.
