12. An act to condemn a lot of land in the vicinity of the Town of Vienna, in Dorchester county, for the repairs of its streets, &c. &c.

13. An act prohibiting Justices of the Peace from exercising their civil duties in Bar Rooms of Taverns, or other public houses of that character, so far as relates to Baltimore county.

14. An act to condemn a lot of ground for the repairs of the causeway at the draw bridge in Dorchester county.

15. An act to provide for the building of a public bridge over Birch Branch in Worcester county.

16. An act for the relief of the German Reformed and Lutheran Congregations of Salem Church, in Boonsborough, Washington county.
