Resolution in favour of Julianna Brice.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Julianna Brice, during life, out of any unappropriated money in the treasury, in semi-annual payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a Lieutenant, in consideration of the services rendered by her husband during the revolutionary war.

Resolution in favor of William Moore, of Somerset County.

Passed March 21.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay to William Moore, of Somerset county, or to his order, during life, in quarter yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the hal' pay of a private, in consideration of services rendered by him during the revolutionary war.
