CHAP. 64.

Sec. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the General Assembly of Maryland reserves the right, to change, alter or annul this act of incorporation at any time.

CHAPTER 63.

*An act to confirm an act, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, chapter two hundred and thirty-two, altering and amending the Constitution of this State, so far as relates to election districts in Baltimore county.*

Passed Feb. 15, 1833

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the act passed at the last session of the General Assembly of this State, chapter two hundred and thirty-two, relating to election districts in Baltimore county, be, and the same is hereby confirmed and made valid, and declared to be made a part of the constitution of this State.

CHAPTER 64.

*An act to authorise the Commissioners of Washington county, to levy upon the assessable property of said county, a sum or sums of money, in cases of Epidemics.*

Passed Feb. 15, 1833

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Commissioners of Washington county be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered to levy upon the taxable property of said county, such sum or sums of money, as may be sufficient to defray the expenses that have been incurred by any citizen, or citizens, or corporation in said county, in making provision for the accommodation and attendance of the poor of said county, who were attacked by the Cholera; the accounts or claims presented, to be in every case satisfactorily vouched for.
