Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That His Excellency the Governor be and he is hereby authorised to let out to any person or persons desiring to lease the same, any vacant or unoccupied lot or lots lying within the limits of Maryland and belonging to the State, for such time and on such terms as he may deem reasonable and most conducive to the public interest, the rents and profits arising from the letting out of any such lot or lots belonging to the tobacco fund of the State, shall be received and charged by the Treasurer for and on account of the said tobacco fund, the residue to be received on general account.
