CHAP. 26.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the place for holding the elections for said district be at Fairmount in said district. Place of holding elections.

**CHAPTER 25.**

*AN ACT to change the name of Charles Carroll Tucker, of the city of Baltimore, to Charles Tucker Carroll.* Passed Feb. 5, 1852.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the name of Charles Carroll Tucker, of the city of Baltimore, be, and the same is hereby changed to Charles Tucker Carroll, and that it shall be lawful for the said Charles Tucker Carroll, at all times hereafter, to be called and known by, and hold and use the name of Charles Tucker Carroll, and by that name to have the right to purchase, sell, convey, devise or receive property hereafter devised, to sue and be sued in any court of law or equity. Name changed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from its passage. In force.

**CHAPTER 26.**

*AN ACT to authorise the Burgess and Commissioners of Emmittsburg, in Frederick county, to appropriate a part of their public grounds to the use of the Trustees of Primary School District, number forty-one, of Frederick county.* Passed Feb. 16, 1852.
