AN ACT concerning

Theft-Related Offenses and Bad Checks

FOR the purpose of providing clarifying and qualifying language to certain provisions pertaining to theft-related offenses and bad checks; modifying certain provisions pertaining to theft-related offenses and bad checks; specifying certain penalties; modifying and clarifying certain definitions pertaining to theft-related offenses and bad checks; reenacting certain provisions that were repealed by Chapter 849 of 1978 which pertain to fraud by fiduciaries, and failure to return rented motor vehicles and other rented goods; changing penalties for certain breaking and entering offenses; specifying a statute of limitations for certain theft offenses; and generally relating to theft-related offenses and bad checks.
