Mr. Blackiston submitted the following amendment ;

Amend the 6th section in the 14th line, printed bill, by inserting after the word thereafter, "and the Treasurer, and a majority of the seven Directors of said company shall be citizens of Maryland."

Which was read and adopted.

Mr. Whitaker submitted the following amendment ;

Amend 4th line of 6th section by striking out the words "and place," and inserting in lieu thereof, the words "in Baltimore city."

Which was read and adopted.

Mr. Blackiston submitted the following amendment :

At the end of section 8th add "and the principal office of said company, for the transfer of stock and general business, shall at all times be located in the city of Baltimore ;"

Which was read and adopted.

Mr. Whitaker submitted the following amendment ;

Amend 10th section at its close by adding "nor shall said company, in any railway car employed in the conveyance of white persons, allow any negro to enter unless he or she be employed as a servant of some one then a passenger therein ;"

Which was read.
