CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION NO. 8-87

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland and Section 12 and 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1987 Replacement Volume), to repeal and reenact Section 23 of the Charter of the City of Bowie entitled, "Board of Supervisors of Elections - Generally", by amending said Section 23, to provide for two alternatives to be appointed to the Board of Supervisors of Elections and to state
