

(1) PURCHASING AND MANAGING IN THE NAME OF THE STATE LANDS SUITABLE FOR FOREST CULTURE, RESERVES, WATERSHED PROTECTION, STATE PARKS, SCENIC PRESERVES, HISTORIC MONUMENTS, PARKWAYS, AND STATE RECREATIONAL RESERVES;

(2) ANNUAL PAYMENTS TO COUNTIES IN THE AMOUNT OF:

(I) IF THE STATE FOREST OR PARK RESERVE COMPRISES LESS THAN 10% OF THE TOTAL LAND AREA OF THE COUNTY, A SUM EQUAL TO 15% OF THE NET REVENUE DERIVED FROM THE STATE FOREST OR PARK RESERVE LOCATED IN THAT COUNTY; AND

(II) IF THE STATE FOREST OR PARK RESERVE COMPRISES 10% OR MORE OF THE TOTAL LAND AREA OF THE COUNTY, A SUM EQUAL TO 25% OF THE NET REVENUE DERIVED FROM THE STATE FOREST OR PARK RESERVE LOCATED IN THAT COUNTY.

(H) (1) THE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.

(2) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND ~~MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED OR REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE, BUT SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND~~ SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

(I) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.

~~(J) ANY UNSPENT PORTIONS OF THE FUND AT THE END OF A FISCAL YEAR SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.~~

(a) (1) In this section[, "concession operations"] THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "ACCOUNT" MEANS THE FOREST OR PARK CONCESSION ACCOUNT.

(3) (I) "CONCESSION OPERATIONS" means activities within a State forest or park that:

[(i)] 1. Raise revenue;

[(ii)] 2. Function under a separate budget system; and

[(iii)] 3. Supplement the operation of the facility where it is located.

[(2)] (II) "Concession operations" includes:

[(i)] 1. Food concessions;

[(ii)] 2. Boat rentals;

[(iii)] 3. Gift shops;
