BY THE COMMITTEE OF CLAIMS,

Your Committee report, that they have examined the proceedings and documents of George Mackubbin, Treasurer of the Western Shore of Maryland, and find from an account settled to 1st Dec. 1829, by the Committee of Claims, of the last General Assembly, there then remained in the Treasury, \$335,104 74, Funded 3 per cent Stock, \$3,143 95 in bills on credit, of the emission under an act of Congress of the 18th March 1780, and \$54,052 57 cents cash:—

That it appears to your Committee, by the accounts of the said Treasurer, he has received from the 1st December 1829, to the 1st December 1830.
