241. An act to incorporate the village commonly called and known by the name of Nine bridges and to change the name thereof to Bridgetown in Caroline county.

242. A supplement to an act, entitled, an act relating to pensions by county assessments, passed at December session 1835, ch. 307, so far as relates to Charles county.

243. An act to incorporate Potatoe Neck Accademy in Somerset county.

244. A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to provide for the administration of justice in cases of crimes and misdemeanors in the city and precincts of Baltimore, passed 1816, ch. 193.

245. An act to condemn and lay off a lot of ground for a public landing or a certain tract of land called Rock Neck in St. Mary's county and make a public road therein mentioned.

246. An act to provide for the appointment of a wood corder in the town of Havre de Grace, in Harford county.

247. An act to incorporate the Superannuated Fund Society of the Maryland Annual Conference.

248. An act to make valid certain proceedings of the orphans' court of Prince George's county.

249. An act to make valid a deed from Henry Lamar and Freena his wife, to Jacob Otto.

250. An act to authorise John Lammott, former collector of the third collection district of Baltimore county, (now part in Carroll) to complete his collections.

251. An act for the relief of Duff Green.

252. An act authorising certain commissioners therein named to execute a deed to Brice J. Goldsborough, his heirs and assigns.

253. An act to build a bridge over Swanson's Creek, a dividing line of Charles and Prince George's counties, at or near McPherson's Mill.

254. An act for the relief of Francis Herbert, of St. Mary's county.

255. An act for regulating the action of justices of the peace in certain cases, in Montgomery county.

256. An act to divorce James Ridgely, of the city of Baltimore, from his wife Eliza G. Ridgely.

257. A further additional supplement to an act passed December session 1835, establishing magistrates' courts in the several counties of this State, and prescribing their duties, so far as relates to St. Mary's county.

258. An act to change the name of Sally Ann Post Fechtig, of Washington county, to Sarah Ann Post.

259. An act for the relief of Sarah Ryan and Letty Cracklen, of Prince George's county.

260. An act, supplementary to an act, to incorporate the Upper Marlbro' Academy in the town of Upper Marlboro', in Prince George's county, passed December session 1835, ch. 240.
