LI. **And be it enacted,** That the collector of each county shall, on or before the tenth day of October next, receive from the persons chargeable in his county, the said second payment, in such specific articles, and at such times, as shall be hereafter fixed by the legislature, or in Spanish dollars at seven shillings and six-pence each, other silver or gold, or new bills of credit at their comparative passing value; and if any person shall not make the said second payment by the said tenth day of October next, the respective collector is hereby authorized and required to collect the same by distress and sale, in the manner before directed as to the first collection, and sales on distress shall then be made for money only, in Spanish dollars at the rate aforesaid, payable in other silver or gold, or new bills of credit, as aforesaid; and the collectors shall make such payments as are before directed, and his final account shall be settled by the commissioners on or before the first day of November next, and the balance thereof shall be paid by the tenth day of November next, in the same manner and under the like penalty as before directed as to the first account, and for not duly paying his first balance, and the like proceedings shall be had on his bond as are before mentioned, and the said commissioners are hereby directed to settle, adjust, and transmit, the said second account, in the same manner as they are directed as to the first.

LII. **And be it enacted,** That if any of the days appointed by this act for the performance of any of the duties hereby required, shall happen to be a Sunday, then such duties shall be performed on the day following.

Collector to
pay commis-
sioners, &c.

LIII. **And be it enacted,** That the collector of each respective county shall, at the time of settlement of his account as aforesaid, pay to each of the said commissioners, who shall serve in the execution of this act, as a salary for the full and faithful performance of his duty therein, twelve shillings and six-pence for each day he shall necessarily attend; and shall also pay to the said commissioners, for the use of their clerk, the allowance herein before directed; and for the use of the said assessors, for the full and faithful performance of their duty under this act, any sum not under five pounds nor exceeding twenty pounds for each assessor, which the said commissioners shall judge an adequate reward for his service; and the amount of all the sums so paid shall, by the said commissioners, be allowed to the said collector on settlement of his account as aforesaid, in which account shall be expressed the name of the clerk, and the names of the assessors for each hundred, and the sum of money to them respectively allowed; and the said commissioners shall, after receipt of the said sums for the use of their clerk and of the said assessors, pay the same to them or their orders respectively on demand, under the penalty of thirty pounds to the party grieved.

Commission-

LIV. **And be it enacted,** That every commissioner, who shall take upon himself the execution of this act, shall, for and during the time he shall continue to act as commissioner, be exempt from all military duty.
