THE House met.—Present the same members as on yesterday.—The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill to prevent the erection of booths within three miles of any Methodist camp or quarterly-meeting, in Queen Anne's county was read the second time by special order; and on motion by Mr. H. Hall the question was put, That the words "three miles" be stricken out of the first clause? *Resolved* in the affirmative.

On motion by Mr. Emory, the words "two miles" was inserted in lieu thereof. On motion by Mr. Stevens, "Talbot county" was inserted in said bill. On motion by Mr. Griffith the question was put, That "Dorchester county" be inserted after Talbot county?
