THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES,

At the December Session of 1828.

MARYLAND, &c.

At a Session of the General Assembly of the State of Maryland, which was begun and held in the State-House, at the City of Annapolis, in the county of Anne-Arundel, on the last Monday of December, (to wit, the twenty-ninth day of the month,) in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight, and in the fifty-third year of the Independence of the United States of America, conformably to the constitution and form of government of the said state; the following proceedings occurred in the House of Delegates, viz.

At eleven o'clock A. M. of said day, the names of the gentlemen declared and returned to have been duly elected on the first Monday in October last, as delegates to the General Assembly, for the respective counties of the said state, and the cities of Annapolis and Baltimore, were, as usual, called over by the clerk of the last House of Delegates, according to the seniority of said counties and cities, in the following order, to wit:

From the county of Saint-Mary's—Richard Thomas, John T. Hawkins, Stephen H. Gough and William J. Blakistone, esquires.

From the county of Kent—Samuel G. Osborn, David I. Campbell, Thomas B. Hynson and William W. Brown, esquires. (See note 1)

From the county of Anne-Arundel—Charles R. Stewart, Thomas Hood, Robert W. Kent and Richard G. Stockett, esquires.

From the county of Calvert—John Beckett, Thomas Billingsley, Samuel Turner and Mordecai F. Smith, esquires.

From the county of Charles—John G. Chapman, James D. Mitchell, Philip King and Thomas Rogerson, esquires.

From the county of Baltimore—James Turner, Hugh Ely, Abraham H. Price and Adam Shower, esquires.

From the county of Talbot—William Hughlett, Spry Denny, Levin Millis and Henry Spencer, esquires.
