Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the amount of nett revenue, which accrued from the Inspection of Tobacco in the state inspection at Baltimore from 1st April 1824, to the year ending December 1st, 1825. and which was applied to the general purposes of the state, ought to be appropriated to the liquidation of the debt due for the election of state ware.houses for the Inspection of Tobacco in the city of Baltimore.

Mr. Done, Chairman of the Library Committee, reported the following resolution.

Resolved by the General Assembly, of Maryland That the librarian be, and he is hereby authorized, under the directions of the joint committee on the library, to dispose of all the volumes of the laws of Maryland, including Kelty's Index, now in the Library; reserving twenty five sets for the use of the Legislature; and the joint committee are authorized and directed to lay out the proceeds thereof in the purchase of law books for the use of the State Library.
