Mr. Teackle presented a petition of William M. Jones, and others, of Somerset county, praying a repeal of so much of the constitution and form of government as relates to the Hungary Neck district and the voters thereof, may be entitled to vote at Princess Anne,

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Teackle, Long, and Jones.

Mr. Carroll, of Balt. county, presented a memorial of James Mouat, John Myers, Alexander Cummins, Clark Cottrell, and others, of the city of Baltimore, praying that the election laws may be amended, so as to prevent illegal voting in said city,

Which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. Long presented a petition of Alexander Donoho, of Somerset county, praying that the levy court of said county, may be authorised and required to levy upon the assessable property of said county, the sum of \$531 73 cents, as additional compensation for extra services rendered by said petitioner in constructing a bridge across Law's Thoroughfare,

Which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

Mr. Fowler, presented a petition of Edmund Benton Greenwell, of St. Mary's county, a revolutionary soldier, praying to be placed on the pension roll of this State,

Which was read and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.

Mr. Heard presented a memorial of Joseph Harris, and others, citizens of St. Mary's county, praying for the passage of an act to incorporate the Leonard Town Academy,

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Heard, Fowler, and Carroll of St. Mary's.

Mr. Carroll, of Balt. county, presented a petition of the trustees of the Franklin Academy of Baltimore county, and other citizens of said county, praying a donation from the State to said academy,
